Grass Cutting and Maintenance

(9th April 2018 to 8th April 2019)

The Parish Council invites tenders to cut the grass at Widegates Village Green, to include the grass strip between the road and the Green as well as the grass immediately surrounding the bus shelter.

The grass would require cutting on a two weekly basis during the months of May through to September with additional cuts being carried out pre-events if required, and twice during the period of October through to April. All grass cuttings would need to be disposed of accordingly.

Maintenance of the flower bed is to be carried out on a monthly basis from May through to September, and twice during the months of October through to April so that the border remains weed free and the shrubs pruned and maintained as necessary.

An observational check of trees and shrubs for structure damage will be required at the start of the contract, and six monthly thereafter, with potentially harmful shrubs or plants being identified at the same time.

Also, the area immediately surrounding the council notice board at Sandplace would need trimming back at least twice during the twelve month period and the cuttings disposed of appropriately.

The successful applicant will need to have adequate public liability cover, and evidence of this is to be provided with the application which is to show the full annual cost for this work. A method statement/risk assessment of how this work will be carried out in a safe manner, and copies of any relevant certificates, should be included. Please note, applications submitted without these documents will not be considered.

Applications are to be returned to the clerk by the 29th March 2018, for consideration by the council at its meeting to be held on the 4th April 2018.
