26/075 Apologies for Absence

26/076 Declarations of Interest on items on the Agenda

Councillor Kitson declared an interest in planning application PA26/02517.

26/077 Open Forum/Public Participation

A parishioner asked if a planning application could go ahead without going on the planning portal. Councillor Gibbons confirmed that all applications are listed on the portal. It was suggested that parishioners set up an alert for any areas they are interested in.

M Willmott confirmed that to get Outlook out by the 1st of the month the copy deadline is the 14 of the prior month. Outlook comes out 10 times a year with a double issue for August/September and December/January.

Morval Estate gave an overview of application PA26/02517.

Councillor Gibbons confirmed that lock chip would be going down on Tregoad dip. Cornwall Council owns a 10,000-acre county farms estate consisting of around 80 holdings. Following an inquiry, the Council's sustainable growth committee ruled out a wholesale sell-off. There is a dentistry summit being run by Cornwall Council for residents on the 17 July and residents can submit any questions for the expert panel through the Lets Talk Cornwall website. The Community Chest funding is now open.
