07.20/08 Derelict Signpost

The Clerk advised that he had contacted Highways regarding the signpost and they have confirmed that we can take it away and put it to good use.

Cllr Collings is happy to oversee this project and will arrange with Andrew Chudleigh to remove it from its current location. The signpost will be stored until a decision is made as to what to do with it.

07.20/09 Report from the Clerk

- (a) Following the resignation of the NDP group chair, Mr Mike Willmot will take over the lead on this very valuable project. The Clerk advised that as the group get nearer to completion there will be a need for the parish council members to become more involved as it will be the future blue print of the council's planning decisions.
- (b) MA Griggs are sending a refund of £59.40 for the bags of road salt they failed to deliver.
- (c) The Clerk has purchased a 12-month Zoom package, under delegated authority, on behalf of the parish council. It is obviously available for the NDP group to use, as they have struggled to arrange a meeting during the last few months (the clerk will need to host the meetings).
- (d) The clerk has updated the Standing Orders and requested that they are checked. The Clerk is to email/post a copy to each of the councillors.

07.20/10 Cornwall Councillor Report

Cllr Pugh gave an overview of his activities that may affect the parish since the last meeting:

- (a) Cllr Collings asked whether it would be possible to provide the Outlook Magazine with the new bus timetable. No problem says Cllr Pugh.
- (b) Cornwall Libraries are coming back on stream next week, so it will be possible to choose the book(s) on-line and pick them up.
- (c) The saw mill at Sandplace is currently being visited by law enforcement due to the excessive noise and air pollution.
- (d) There is currently a lot of research taking place by Cornwall Council regarding Ash Die Back. We should have received some emails regarding this.
- (e) The full council is meeting up, using Teams, next week which is good news.
- (f) Yes, grants up to £10,000 are currently available for village halls so the village hall committee should be looking into it.
