The Clerk had the following update from CORMAC Highways and Environment Manager

- a. Pedestrian Refuge A387/B3253
 The refuge is a promising idea to allow a safe crossing point for users of the bus and current shop. This is a good example to nominate on the future CNP highways scheme.
- b. Bus Stop

The area is not large enough for a stop and would require extensive earthworks and sign repositioning to allow for a hardstanding to be installed. I have asked if there is a possibility for just a timetable and post to be erected here.

- c. Farriers Way Bond
 - The bond has now been called in and a purchase order has been raised within Cornwall Council. The construction of an adoptable bell mouth, associated footpath works together with moving and illuminating speed limit signs. There is no confirmed date yet. The repositioning of the 30mph signs will need to follow the consultation process again
- d. Dragons Teeth road markings

 Mr Hutchins mentioned the dragons
 - Mr Hutchins mentioned the dragons teeth have not been install when the 30mph limit has been moved as part of the CNP works. I have checked the scheme brief for the works, the instruction for dragons teeth was never agreed or finalised, therefore was not included. I can look into funding options for this in the new financial year
- e. Morval nameplate Sign
 If the Parish want to look into the purchasing of a sign please let me know. This could also be a nomination for the CNP highways scheme
- f. Devolution of grass cutting through Widegates
 Make contact with the Community Link Officer for the area David Reed.
