St Wenna's Church

St Wenna's Church is now formally part of the new Looe Valley Benefice, where the partner churches of Looe, Duloe, Herodsfoot and Morval work together but maintain separate identities. The Clergy and local worship team are able to maintain services every Sunday and on the fifth week they will join with other churches.

During the past year, church members ran stalls at Widegates Summer Fair and Morval Country Fete. In October an evening celebration of St Wenna and Harvest, with music by local musicians Ilow Splann and followed by a bring and share Harvest Supper, was well supported.

The Christmas Tree festival was held in early December. This included trees supplied and decorated by a number of local organisations, with the stewarding covered by church members. The Carol Service and Trenode School's Christingle service were held during the festival.

The conversion of the side aisle into St Wenna's Chapel (for use when required on Sundays) and St Wenna's Community Room (for use as required on other days) has very recently been essentially completed, and improvements to the church heating system will occur during the summer months.

Finally, last Sunday Mr & Mrs Wilks opened their gardens at Churchtown as a church fundraiser. Visitors could stroll around the grounds, and there was also a fine selection of cakes and quiche, with teas & coffee.
