The Emergency Alerts system is used to warn if there's a danger to life nearby,

Compatible mobile phones and tablets will receive an alert, make a loud sirenlike sound and vibrate, even if your phone is on silent. You will not need to take any action. Those experiencing domestic abuse with hidden phones could be put at risk if






